## Summer Safari 2018



The 2018 Summer Photo Safari will take you on a full day 120 mile round trip to see some of the delights of East Lothian.

To start the Summer Safari head to Haddington. After leaving the A1 carry on through the town and park in the ALDI supermarket car park. Walk back towards the town over the Victoria Bridge.

1	Take a shot of the weir including the red pantiled building.
2	From the other side take another shot of the weir and the river beyond.
	Head over the bridge and take the 1st left
3	Look out for the statue of the Goats of Haddington and take a shot of it.
	Cross the road and follow the riverside walk down Church Street. Go in to St Mary's Pleasance Gardens.
4	Take a shot of the orchard with the church of St Mary's in the background
5	Take another shot of the gardens looking back towards the town.
6	Take a shot of St Mary's front elevation.
7	Take a shot of the church from the east.
8	Walk down to the River Tyne and take a shot of the river including the weeping willow trees.
9	Take a shot of the doocot.
10	Take a shot of the Nunnrow bridge.
11	Cross the bridge and take a shot from the bridge of the river to include St Mary's
	Head next for Hailes Castle. Leave the Aldi car park and go back to the main road. Turn right and keep going until you see the brown sign on the left for Hailes Castle 1 mile. Park in the layby near the castle (free entry).
12	Take a shot of the castle from the entrance.
13	Take a shot of the red sandstone arch.

14	From the east side take a shot that includes the river Tyne
15	Take a shot of the doocot within the castle.
16	Take a shot of the Great Hall.
17	Take a shot of the bakehouse vaulted ceiling.
18	Next go down to the river and take a shot of the castle façade including the river.
	Now head back to the car and carry on to East Linton and follow signs for Preston Mill. Park in car park.
19	Take a shot of Preston Mill.
20	Take a shot of the water wheel.
21	Take a shot of the mill to include the millpond.
22	Next walk out to the river and take a shot of the weir.
	Back to your car now and head for Dunbar and park in the harbour area.
23	Take a shot of the Victoria Harbour
24	And another shot of the castle.
25	Take a shot of the battery to include the Bass Rock.
26	From the battery walk along the pier to the entrance and take a shot of the kittiwakes.
27	Next climb the sea wall and take a shot of the rocks.
28	Walk round to Cromwell Harbour and take a shot of the Dunbar Fisherman's Monument and Barometer.
29	Take a shot of Cromwell Harbour.
	Back to your car and head on the Berwick road looking out for the sign on the left for Barns Ness. Carry on down to the lighthouse here where you can ark in the car park £2 daily charge. Go down to the coastal path.
30	Take a shot of the lighthouse.
31	Plus a shot of the light keepers' houses.
	Back to the car and head down the A1 – at the roundabout take the left to Cove and park in the small car park there. Take the path down to Cove harbour.
32	At the start of the path take a team shot next to the Widows of Cove Memorial.

33	On the way down take a shot of the bay and cliffs.
34	Take a shot of the tunnel.
35	Take a shot of the sandy bay.
36	Take a shot of the bay with the red cliffs.
37	And another shot of the holiday houses.
	Go back through the tunnel, turn right and go down to the fishermen's houses and harbour.
38	On the way down take a shot of the houses.
39	Take another shot of the houses from the quayside.
40	If there are fishing boats in take a shot of these if not take a shot of the quayside.
41	From the end of the pier take an overall shot of the harbour.
42	Take a shot of the rusty bollards and chain at the end of the pier.
43	Take a final shot of the creels on the quayside.
