### Winter Safari 2018



**The 2018 Winter Photo Safari will take you to Pitlochry and the Hermitage by Dunkeld. A bright and sunny autumn or winter's day would be ideal for this safari and you may even be in time to catch some autumn colours in the foliage. To start the Winter Safari head through Pitlochry veering left to the boating station at Loch Faskally just north of the town. Park in the car park at the boating station/café.**

1	Take a shot of the loch including the boats (if they are out).
2	Also take a shot of the loch from the wooden jetty.
3	From the jetty walk uphill on the woodland path and take a shot of the path. Then carry on to the bridge.
4	Take a shot of the road bridge.
5	Take a shot of the footbridge.
6	From the footbridge take a shot across the loch towards the Green hotel.
7	Also take a shot of the loch to the north from the footbridge.
8	Take a shot of both bridges together.
	<b>Now head back to the car and into Pitlochry. Turn right in the town and go down to park in the Pitlochry Dam visitors' car park.</b>
9	Walk up towards the new Visitor Centre and take a shot of the building.
10	Go inside, through the café and take a shot of the Dam from the balcony. (Note that from November the centre might close on Mon/Tues – check before you go)
	<b>Now go back out of the Visitor Centre and take the steps down to the Dam.</b>
11	From the dam take a shot of the Visitor Centre.
12	From the dam, take a shot of the river below the dam.
13	Also take a shot of Loch Faskally above the dam.
14	Now walk down to the fish ladder and take a shot of it.
15	From the fish ladder take a shot of the dam.

16	Now walk down to the Pitlochry Festival Theatre and take a shot of the theatre.
17	From the Fisherman's Bar take a shot of the suspension footbridge.
18	Take a shot of Port-na-Craig restaurant.
19	And a shot of the Ferryman's cottage.
20	Take another shot of the footbridge.
21	Go to the centre of the footbridge and take a shot of the dam from there.
	<b>Now take the riverside path on the opposite bank of the river back towards the Visitor Centre. From there head back down towards the car park then walk up the hill turning right towards the railway station. (If preferred you could head into town and then to the station)</b>
22	At the station take a shot of the signal box.
23	Take a shot of the metal footbridge.
24	Then a shot of the waiting room.
25	And a shot of the ticket office.
26	Take an overall shot or panorama of the station.
	<b>Now head back to your car and go back down the A9 to the Hermitage (NTS) just outside Dunkeld. Free parking is available at the Hermitage on your right off the A9.</b>
27	Take a shot of the old railway bridge on the right at the start of the walk.
28	Go through the short tunnel and take a shot of the path.
29	Walk along the path and take a shot of the tall pine trees.
30	Take a canopy shot of the tall trees.
31	Walk on to the viewing area below the stone bridge and take a shot of the pool below the bridge.
32	Take a shot of the stone bridge.
33	Take a shot of the falls from the stone bridge.
34	Take a shot of the falls from the balcony inside Ossian's Hall.
35	Take a shot back to Ossian's Hall from the path above the falls.
36	And a shot of the stone bridge from the falls.
37	Take a river scene from further up the path.

38	Return to the viewing area and take a shot of the trees here.
39	Take a team shot around the bench overlooking the pool below the stone bridge.
40	Follow the right hand path on the way back and take a final shot of your choice of the river.
